Dear Al,

Thank you very much for the donation from Baptist Health Care to the Decatur General Disaster Relief Fund. We have had tremendous support and raised over \$11,000 to assist our employees and their families as well as patients who were affected by the tornadoes on April 27, 2011.

Our friend Bryan Kindred and DCH thankfully avoided a direct hit by an EF5 tornado by probably less than 200 yards. Even though Decatur was also spared a direct hit by a tornado, one did destroy all of the power transmission lines from the Browns Ferry Nuclear Power Plant. However there was one tornado, with estimated winds of 200 miles per hour, which started on the west side of the state and traveled an estimated 132 miles on the ground. This tornado affected more Decatur General employees than any other and was also responsible for the majority of patients we received on that day. The money from our Disaster Relief Fund, including your generous donation, is helping these individuals to rebuild their homes and lives. Living on the coast, you understand the damage and devastation caused primarily by hurricanes in your case, and the expenses incurred by individuals that are not always covered by homeowners insurance, FEMA, or some other type of assistance. Our Disaster Relief Fund is helping fill that void so that our employees will not have to suffer further as a result of these storms.
