UPDATE

We are continuing to make progress on our first phase of “Building a Better Baptist”, and the following are currently underway:

Main Hospital

Medical Meeting Room corridor that runs from the Towers to the Emergency Department entrance – flooring installation began August 17.

Corridor that runs between the Emergency Department and the Doctors’ Lounge – flooring installation is scheduled to begin August 30.

Corridor that runs in front of Interventional Radiology to the Surgical Waiting Room – drywall repairs and priming began the week of August 16. Floor tile removal will begin August 31.

Atrium in the front lobby corridor on the ground floor of the main hospital – The atrium glass is being replaced brick and ceiling to avoid future water leaks. Customers can continue to access the front lobby during the day via a temporary door that’s being constructed along the west side of the Main Lab. The temporary door should be complete by the end of the week of August 16.

Ground floor corridor that runs from the Bistro entrance and tray return area to the Inpatient Pharmacy – Demolition began the week of August 16.

Baptist Medical Towers

Tower 1 entrance corridor – ceiling installation is complete. The flooring demolition and installation for this area began August 17.

Corridor that runs from the Tower 3 entrance to the Heart Center entrance – demolition of the corridor and public restrooms began August 18, and is expected to be completed by October.

Our contractors continue to perform the majority of their work at night in order to minimize disruption to daily activities. We will also continue to place temporary signage throughout these areas in order to maintain way finding and safety during all phases.
